Dialogue on the Ground

Overall Aim:

- To provide opportunities for individuals to engage in dialogue and discuss contentious issues of the past



Ways that this will be Delivered:

- Issue based dialogue sessions
- A series of workshops to unpack topics at a deeper level
- Residentials to allow more time for reflection on opinions, ideas and concepts



As a Result

- People can deal with these and move forward together
- The dialogue approach will help transform understanding between diverse groups and individuals and lead to better and enhanced relationships
- This will contribute to the development of better understanding and assist the smooth transition to peace and reconciliation

Unravelling the Jargon

Aim:

- To take governmental policy and strategy and simplify these documents into 'lay terms'



Ways that this will be Delivered

Pamphlets will be produced and workshops held to help the community at large understand the basic components and assist them in making informed choices about their future



As a Result

Groups most affected by the conflict and those marginalised groups in society are able to read and understand the strategic policy that frames their future



The workshops will enable participants to become more informed and to share with one another the issues important to them that are contained in these documents
